Honorable Gentlemen:

Orange County is desirous of creating a protected small craft harbor at Dana Point, California.

Some progress toward this end has been accomplished locally. Before additional development can be made, it is necessary that a Survey Report be prepared by the Corps of Engineers, U. S. Army.

The preparation of such a Survey Report was eminent at the time of the Korean emergency when all such projects were suspended. On December 3, 1957 the Orange County Board of Supervisors, upon recommendation of the Orange County Harbor Commission, adopted a resolution requesting that the California State Small Craft Harbors Commission approve this project in high priority to the United States Congress and that funds be included in the next federal budget for such a Survey Report of Dana Point Harbor. The California State Small Craft Harbors Commission at its meeting of December 9, 1957 approved Dana Point as a Small Craft Harbor and recommended favorably on the request made.

Pursuant to the authority of the Board of Supervisors and the approval given by the State Commission, I hereby request your active support of this request.
